I Will If You Will (IWIYW) is a campaign to help the **women, girls and families** of Bury to get more active, more often and have fun while they do it.

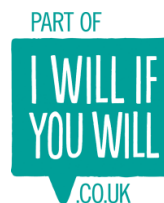
Funded by **Sport England** and delivered by **Bury Council**, this initiative is about local people getting together and trying something new.
